# Axle Breaks on Turnpike, Car Rolls, Airman Killed

ELKTON, Md. — An airman was killed early today in an accident on the John F. Kennedy Memorial Highway, 3 miles south of Elkton.

Samuel Rodney Hinwood III, 19, of Rockville, Ind., who had been with an Air Force support group at Ft. Meade, sustained head and internal injuries in the accident, shortly after midnight.

Hinwood died at 2:45 this morning in Union Hospital at Elkton, while plans were being made to transfer him by helicopter to University Hospital in Baltimore.

Police said witnesses reported that an axle on Hinwood's convertible apparently broke, causing the car to go out of control. He was hurled out and the auto rolled over him, police said.

## Slaying Laid to Kin

MILLVILLE — police pressed their search today for Nathaniel Bagwell, 21, of Frankford, accused in the fatal shooting Monday of his brother, Samuel, 19. The shooting, in the yard of Samuel's home on Holt's Landing Road north of Millville climaxed an argument, police said. The suspect is the object of a 13-state alert. The victim was dead on arrival at Beebe Hospital, Lewes.
